 Aluminum & steel cans, plastic/styrofoam containers (DO NOT BAG), corrugated cardboard (flattened & tied) styrofoam blocks (taped).





 Paper, newspapers, magazines, boxboard (single ply), polycoat, plastic bags (bundled) & glass bottles/jars (place on top of papers).

Collection Reminders





- All holiday changes will be published in the local newspaper and online at www.southfrontenac.net/solidwaste.
- ALL Garbage & Recycling must be out by 7am on collection day.
- Only clean food, beverage, household plastic containers, and rigid plastic packaging are accepted in the Blue Box Program.
- Cardboard & styrofoam are limited to three bundles per blue week.
- The maximum weight for garbage and blue boxes is 20 kgs (44 lbs).

TIP: Follow the instructions on the back of your bag tags for how to affix tags and other tips to make sure garbage is picked up!

Blue Week Materials

Material Types	Recyclable Items	Do's & Don'ts
Aluminum & Steel Cans 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Food and beverage cans, lids, and foil plates or trays. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Flatten and clean. NO aerosols, paint cans, heavy metals (pots/pans) or foil laminates (chip bags).
Corrugated Cardboard 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Corrugated cardboard has more than 1 layer (waffle). Bundles no larger than 2'x3'x8". Maximum three (3) bundles. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Flattened, clean, taped & tied. NO box board (single ply), staples and tape residue, or greasy/wax coated cardboard.
Household Plastics 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Food, beverage, health & beauty, and non-hazardous cleaning product containers, jugs and bottles. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Collapse and clean all items. NO hard plastics, such as toys, hazardous waste containers, plastic cutlery or plates/cups.
White Styrofoam Trays & Packaging 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> White styrofoam trays and block/sheet packaging. Blocks or sheets of packing styrofoam (please bundle). 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Bundles should be taped/tied and no larger than 2'x3'x8". NO packing popcorn/peanuts or coloured styrofoam of any type.

Yellow Week Materials

Material Types	Recyclable Items	Do's & Don'ts
Household Glass 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Consumable glass food and beverage containers or bottles. Clear or coloured glass, including wine or alcohol. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ensure containers are clean - lids can be left on. NO broken glass, ceramics, mirrors, or glass cups/plates.
Paper & Single Ply Boxboard 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Paper products, magazines, junk mail, shredded paper (limits apply). Single-ply box board, such as cereal/cracker boxes. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> NO photographs, wrapping or tissue paper, tissues, paper towel, or paper bags lined with foil (pet food, chips, coffee, etc.).
Stretchable Plastic Bags 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Stretchable plastics only with any handles or zippers removed. If the bag stretches when pulled, it is recyclable. If it tears, it is not. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> NO heavy overwrap (mattress bags, plastic over pop flats, etc.), chip bags, or soiled plastic wrap.
Polycoat Gabled Cartons 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Milk, cream or juice cartons. Broth or soup cartons. Carton drink boxes such as juice boxes or tetra packs. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Rinse cartons and flatten. NO drink straws or remaining residue permitted.
